

# Australian College of Physiotherapists: Standing Committees Nomination Form



The four (4) ACP Standing Committees provide advice and guidance on the APA Career Pathway; they report to the Australian College of Physiotherapists Council (College Council).

Definitions of the College Council and College Standing Committees are outlined below:

**ACP** means the **Australian College of Physiotherapists**

**College Council** is the group of members who provide strategic oversight on APA Career Pathway and professional development. The four (4) ACP Standing Committees report to College Council.

**ACP Assessment and Credentialing Standing Committee (ACSC)** provides strategic and operational oversight of all assessment and credentialing requirements for ACP Titling and Fellowship programs, including the appointment, training and education of examiners and assessors. .

**ACP Standards and Quality Standing Committee (SQSC)** provides strategic oversight, advice and guidance on the quality and standards of ACP training programs, career pathways and associated activities to ensure quality assurance, continuous improvement and risk management.

**ACP Fellowship Pathways Standing Committee (FPSC)** provides strategic and operational oversight of all ACP Titling and Fellowship programs.

**ACP Appeals, Complaints and Grievances Standing Committee (ACGSC)** reviews alleged appeals, complaints and grievances pertaining to admissions, programs, courses or professional development offered by the APA and ACP.

The ACP Standing Committees are calling for nominations for **members** to take up a **three (3) year term** on a Standing Committee. You may nominate for more than one ACP Standing Committee.

## Summary below of nominations that are open

ACP Assessment and Credentialing Standing Committee	<b>Four (4) vacancies</b>
ACP Standards and Quality Standing Committee	<b>Ten (10) vacancies</b>
ACP Fellowship Pathways Standing Committee	<b>Seven (7) vacancies</b>
ACP Appeals, Complaints and Grievances Standing Committee	<b>Eight (8) vacancies</b>

**If elected to more than one position Standing Committee, the nominee may need to assess workload, and consider potential conflict of interest in determining the acceptance of more than one position.**

The term of office will run from **1st January 2023 and end 31 December 2025**. Successful nominees will have the option of re-nominating to serve on the ACP Standing Committee for a total of two (2) consecutive terms of three (3) years.

If more nominations are received than positions available, a ballot will be held. Otherwise nominee(s) will be elected unopposed.

The College Council encourages physiotherapists from rural or remote areas, and from all sectors of the health workforce to apply.

The ACP Standing Committees generally meet via videoconference on a regular cycle that is determined by the respective Committee and the College support staff.

ACP Standing committees will meet the composition requirements as defined by the [APA Regulations](#) for Committee Role and Responsibilities [PART E]

- may append a personal statement of strictly 250 words or less (which will be used if an election is required) and a brief CV (**no longer than one page**).
