The ACT Symposium Committee invites all physiotherapists and health professionals to submit an abstract for the 2021 ACT Research Symposium to be held at the University of Canberra.

To submit your abstract for a presentation, choose from:

- **1.** Long papers: 12 minutes, suited to the rich experience of research projects or qualitative studies, with 5 minutes Q&A
- **2. Short papers**: suited to case studies, research methods, or research proposals 5 slides in 4 minutes and one question only
- 3. Posters: 800 words max

Submission Process

Your abstract should be submitted online to karen.ide@australian.physio

- Your abstract should be max 250 words. An additional 50 words should be used to discuss clinical implications after the conclusion.
- Please note if it is a long or short paper or poster

Your abstract should be constructed under the headings:

- Introduction
- Method
- Results (abstracts for proposals will have 'anticipated results')
- Conclusions
- Clinical Implications

Abstracts are accepted on the following conditions:

- 1. <u>ALL</u> presenters (paper or poster) <u>MUST register and pay</u> for the Symposium
- 2. Papers must be presented by the authors
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse any paper or poster
- 4. Do not include tables, diagrams or graphs in the abstract
