

Portfolio Submission

Component I. Electronic 'Show Portfolio':

(Demonstrate competency against the **Learning Outcomes** aligned to the <u>Physiotherapy Competence Framework at</u> Milestone 3 level under the following 7 Roles)

PRACTITIONER

- 3 Case Studies (Mandatory): Present three comprehensive case studies highlighting diagnostic and treatment planning skills.
- Additional supportive evidence could include:
 - De-identified case notes, including management plans, referral letters, and any other relevant documentation
 - Logbook of supervised cases

COMMUNICATOR

- Provide examples of referral letters/letters to referring practitioner (de-identified)
- Communication Vignette: Highlight interactions focusing on cultural sensitivity, values, and utilisation of technology
- Submission of Reflection (Reflection template from Component II & III) may be used or cross referenced
- Additional supportive evidence could include:
 - Examples of patient/client records (redacted to meet privacy requirements)
 - o Attendance at appropriate communication course

COLLABORATOR

- Documentation of collaboration: Provide evidence of collaborative efforts within professional or industry bodies including:
 - Negotiating overlapping and shared responsibilities with other health professionals in patient care
 - Strategies to promote understanding, managing differences and/or resolving conflict
 - Safe transfer of care to another health professional, setting or stage of care.
- Additional supportive evidence could include:
 - Collaborator Vignette: Illustrate instances of shared responsibilities, transfer of care, negotiate sharing of care responsibilities, managing differences and conflict resolution
 - Submission of Reflection (Reflection template from Component II & III) may be used or cross referred





LEADER

- Mentorship and support: Showcase involvement in mentoring or supporting colleagues.
- Membership engagement: Demonstrate participation and contributions to relevant professional boards or committees.
- Additional supportive evidence could include:
 - APA Course: "The art of communication in leadership to create an inspiring culture" with reflection
 - Evidence of any other leadership course/workshop attended relevant to practice (to support evidence if needed) and reflection on learning during course and application to practice.

HEALTH ADVOCATE

- Provide evidence of:
 - Working with patients/clients to help identify and address determinants of health that affect them
 - o Incorporating illness and injury prevention, health promotion and/or health surveillance activities into practice
 - o Contribution to improvement of health in the community.
- Additional supportive evidence could include:
 - Health Advocate Vignette: Collaborating with patients to recognise and tackle health determinants, clients adopting healthy behaviours, health prevention, integrating preventative measures, promoting health, and contributing to community health enhancement.
 - Submission of Reflection (Reflection template from Component II & III) may be used or cross referred

SCHOLAR

- <u>PEDro Evidence-Based Physiotherapy Practice Level 3</u> (**Mandatory**, if no other evidence provided) including reflection on learning and application to practice
- Evidence of Professional Development
- Evidence based practice in the treatment and management plans
- Provide evidence of education to Colleagues and Others
- Evidence of Mentoring and Coaching
- Additional supportive evidence could include:
 - Research contributions: Audits, systematic reviews and or involvement in research projects





PROFESSIONAL

- APA Cultural Safety Course: <u>Australian Physiotherapy Council's Cultural Safety Training for Physiotherapists</u> (**Mandatory** or provide evidence of equivalent)
- Cultural reflection evidenced in one Case Study
- Cultural Reflection (Part of Component II Reflection piece)
- Additional supportive evidence (not necessarily cultural) could include:
 - o Demonstrate a commitment to patient/client safety
 - Demonstrate a commitment to patients/clients by applying best practice and high ethical standards
 - Demonstrate commitment to the profession by adhering to relevant legislation, regulations and standards

Component II. Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Cultural Capability Development:

(Ahpra-Shared Code of conduct)

- List Cultural Professional Development within the past three years (for resources refer to <u>Physiotherapy Board-Ahpra guidelines: Continuing professional</u> <u>development</u>)
- Cultural Capability Reflection: Demonstrate understanding and implementation of cultural capability-for resources refer to Ahpra <u>Shared Code of Conduct</u>

Please note:

- ✓ Mandatory Evidence, supporting evidence and the reflection pieces listed above can all be crossed referenced to the various roles. For example Case Study 1 lends itself to the following roles: Practitioner, Communicator, Collaborator, Leader, Professional, and in some cases could also be cross referenced to the Health Advocate and or Scholar role.
- ✓ Progression to the Clinical Examination depends on successfully demonstrating competence in the Portfolio submission, which includes all three components.
