

APA Conference FOCUS26 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander physiotherapy bursaries

The Australian Physiotherapy Association (APA) recognises the importance of a strong Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander physiotherapy workforce, and the significant contribution that physiotherapists make to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health.

The APA is offering up to six (6) bursaries to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander physiotherapy students and early-career physiotherapists to attend the APA FOCUS26 Conference in Cairns on 15 – 17 October 2026.

Each bursary will cover the cost of conference registration, return economy airfares, accommodation and transport.

Eligibility

- Identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person.
- Be currently enrolled in a physiotherapy course at an Australian university OR have graduated from a physiotherapy course within the last two years.
- Not previously received a conference bursary from the APA; and
- Not be a current member of the APA Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Committee.

In assessing all eligible applications, preference will be given to students who are currently in their fourth year of study and to physiotherapists who are currently in their first year of practice.
