

Grants Review Committee Expression of Interest

The Grants Review Committee is a standing committee of the Physiotherapy Research Foundation (PRF). Its primary role is to review the merits of applications for clinical research grants submitted to the PRF and to make recommendations on grant allocations for the consideration of the PRF Committee. Members of the Grants Review Committee are appointed by the PRF Committee.

Responsibilities of the Grants Review Committee members include:

- participating in meetings of the Grants Review Committee;
- evaluation of PRF grant applications;
- making recommendations on grant allocations;
- monitoring the interim and final reports of PRF grant recipients;
- nominating and inviting independent assessors to review grant applications.

The normal term of office for members of the Grants Review Committee shall be three years commencing on 01 January of the year immediately following their appointment and ending on 31 December of the third year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to join the Grants Review Committee you must:

- be a current financial member of the Australian Physiotherapy Association; and
- hold a post graduate qualification(s) as well as experience in conducting, supervising and/or reviewing research relating to physiotherapy.
